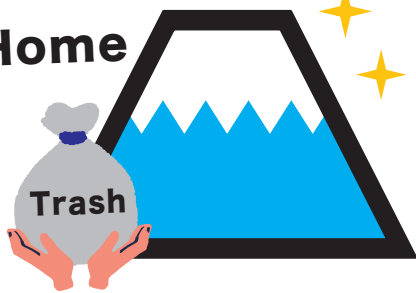

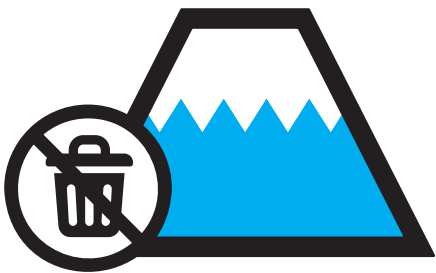
Keep Mount Fuji Clean \\ Take Your Trash Home! //

No Trash Cans on Mt. Fuji.

Bring a trash bag and take all your trash home. Do not leave trash at nearby facilities, shops, or stations.



No Littering!

Littering includes small items such as snack wrappers and cigarette butts.



**Check your gear
before you go!**

Broken boot soles and trekking pole rubber caps are the most common trash left behind on Mt. Fuji.



**Bring the right rain
gear for the mountain.**

Don't use umbrellas or flimsy plastic raincoats. They break easily and end up as litter.
